2. Please select your share/s:

- Single Shrimp Share: 5 lbs of whole shrimp @ \$2.50/lb = \$12.50/week = \$125 for the 10 week season
- Double Shrimp Share: 10 lbs of whole shrimp @ \$2.50/lb = \$25.00/week = \$250 for the 10 week season
- Fish Single Share: 4-6 lbs of whole fish @ \$4.00/lb = \$20/week = \$200 for the 10 week season
- Fish Double Share: 8-12 lbs of whole fish @ \$4.00/lb = \$40/week = \$400 for the 10 week season
- Shrimp and Fish Single Share: Alternating weeks; 5 lbs of whole shrimp one week, 4-6 lbs of whole fish the next week @ \$3.50/lb = \$17.50/week = \$175 for the 10 week season
- Shrimp and Fish Double Share: Alternating weeks; 10 lbs of whole shrimp one week, 8-12 lbs of whole fish the next week @ \$3.50/lb = \$35.00/week = \$350 for the 10 week season

4. PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING SECTIONS CAREFULLY. YOUR SIGNATURE BELOW MEANS YOU UNDERSTAND AND AGREE TO THESE TERMS.

- **The winter season will begin the week of December 7th, 2009 and run for 10 weeks.**
Please have completed contracts returned to us by December 1st, 2009.
- **Please bring a cooler or insulated bag to carry home your seafood share.** We will maintain your seafood shares at the proper temperature during delivery and distribution, but we are not responsible for what happens to it after you pick it up.
- Most of the fish shares you receive will be whole, bone-in fish that is gutted, and gilled. The shrimp will be whole with head on. Certain species, such as whiting, mackerel, or the flatfishes, such as flounder, won't be gutted or gilled due to their anatomically delicate nature.
- If someone else is picking up your share, please make sure they know your shareholder's name on the contract and that they have a cooler or insulated bag to transport the share. All share pick-ups will require a signature on our delivery lists next to the shareholder name.
- Please note that we can only compensate you for a missed share if we make an error. If you miss a pick up, we cannot make up that missed share.
- If you can't make your scheduled pick up, please ask family, friends, or neighbors to pick up your share. Any unclaimed shares will be donated to local food pantries. Economically, we cannot "double-up" shares to accommodate schedule conflicts you may experience.
- You can only change your share or pick up location within the first two weeks of the season.
- Our "daily catch" email is a non-binding description of the seafood you will receive that day.

5. Missed deliveries on our part.

The safety of our fishermen is paramount. If a location's delivery is cancelled due to unsafe weather, or other conditions, you will be notified via your primary email address. We will extend that location's delivery schedule to accommodate the cancellation. If cancellations cause the season to go beyond twelve weeks from that location's starting date, we reserve the right to increase a share's volume to end the season within twelve weeks from the season's starting date.

6. Agreement with this contract.
